What is abuse?

Abuse is any physical, sexual, emotional or psychological mistreatment.

What if you are being abused?

It's not your fault. Support and safety are available. There are people who care and are ready to listen. Talk to someone you trust. **Call the numbers on this page.** Keep asking for help until you get what you need.

What is sexual violence?

Sexual violence is any harmful behavior perceived by the victim to be of a sexual nature which is unwanted and takes place without consent or understanding of the victim.

How can you help someone who is being abused?

If you know someone is being abused or has been assaulted:

- Show them this page, promote access to services in their community or a community of their choosing.
- Believe them, listen to them and respect their privacy.
- Help them plan for their safety. Outreach support for victims of abuse and shelters for women appearing on this page can help with safety planning.
- Respect their right to make decisions about their life when they are ready. Information and support helps them make informed decisions.
