

2022 Policing Budget to Local Governments

In New Brunswick, policing is a local government responsibility. For municipalities that have not established their own police force, municipal policing is provided by the Royal Canadian Mounted Police under contract to the province. The province assesses each municipality its share of the cost, by a formula based on population and tax base.

Below is the 2022 projected cost of policing services for municipalities released by the New Brunswick Department of Justice and Public Safety.
