1. Purpose of the organization

The company is a non-profit company incorporated in 1994 for the purpose of seeking funding and partnership arrangements to facilitate access to distance education in New Brunswick and to support the development of the advanced training technologies sector of the provincial economy. The company is not taxable under the income tax laws of Canada and New Brunswick. The company was inactive in 2006, 2007 and 2008.

2. Significant Accounting Policies

(a) Method of accounting:

The corporation follows the deferral method of accounting for receipts. Restricted receipts are recognized as revenue in the year in which the related expenses are incurred. Unrestricted receipts are recognized as revenue when received or receivable if the amount to be received can be reasonably estimated and collection is reasonably assured.

(b) Donated services:

Donated services are not recorded in the records.

(c) Fair value of financial instruments

Financial instruments of the organization consist of cash and accrued liabilities. The carrying value of the financial instruments approximates their fair value due to their short maturities.

3. Services in kind

The corporation is operated entirely by volunteer services of directors and committee members. Due to the difficulty of determining the fair market value for those services they are not recorded in the financial statements.

4. Discontinuance of activities

During the year the corporation did not seek any new funding sources and does not expect to seek new funding sources in the coming year.
